Vessel Inspection must be performed every week. The VI must be performed by at least two people.

A copy of the VI Schedule is located in the VI Binder onboard the Iona C.

VI may be performed anytime within the week assigned (week = Sunday to Saturday).

If you cannot complete your assigned VI, please arrange to swap with another team. Please advise the VI Coordinator of schedule changes.

If performing the VI at the end of your week (ie Saturday), please let the next VI team know so that they can try to schedule their inspection a little later in their week if possible.

Each weekly VI includes one monthly item that should be checked. Please be sure to complete this item. See the VI Schedule to confirm which monthly item is to be completed.

Please try to resolve issues yourself; the Iona C is your vessel! If any deficiencies are observed during your VI, please advise a Coxswain. Do not assume that noting it in the VI report is sufficient.
